The Stone Circle Tradition of Wicca (USA) is a mystery tradition based in Ecofeminism and Queer Spirituality. SCW exists to promote the spiritual development of dedicants and initiates; to encourage responsible fulfillment of diverse Wiccan vocations (priestess, priestx, or priest); and to offer service to all in Earth's Household. We honor a Divine Spirit of the Universe, which is both One and Many; and may be Male, Female, All Genders, and Beyond Gender.

Open Ceremonies

Join us for Moon Services hosted onsite and/or online and for ceremonial events at the Solar Holidays, Red Dragon in February, or Interdependence Days in July.

Classes Leading to Initiation

Meeting online once each moon for a year and a day (13 moons), the class introduces students to core ethical, cosmological, liturgical, and theological teachings and trains each student to design and lead public ceremony. Each class provides lessons on Wiccan religion, ritual, and magic. Each class focuses on one of the 13 sacred Tools: The Cord, The Book, The Drum, The Blade, The Censer, The Dish, The Cauldron, The Schmatta, The Chalice, The Bowl, The Mirror, The Candle, The Wand.
